## PROCLAMATION OF SUSPENSION OF OPEN BURNING AND OPEN BURNING PERMITS

Due to the anticipated high winds, high temperatures and low humidity throughout the County of San Bernardino, I hereby suspend all open burning and burn permits in the following geographic areas pursuant to San Bernardino County Fire Protection Ordinance §26:

- **Division 1 – All unincorporated West Valley areas, as well as the Cities of Fontana and Upland.**
- **Division 2 – All unincorporated East Valley areas, as well as the Cities of San Bernardino and Grand Terrace.**
- **Division 3 – All Mountain Areas, except for within the Running Springs Fire District and the Big Bear Fire Authority boundaries.**
- **Division 4 – All unincorporated South Desert and River Areas, as well as the Town of Yucca Valley, the City of 29 Palms, and the City of Needles, with the exception of Morongo Valley.**
- **Division 5 – All unincorporated High Desert and North Desert Areas, as well as the City of Hesperia and City of Adelanto, with the exception of Yermo, Daggett, and Newberry Springs.**

**THIS SUSPENSION SHALL TAKE EFFECT AT 0600 HOURS MONDAY, MAY 23, 2022  
AND SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL LIFTED**

### PLEASE NOTE:

- Open fires conducted in the course of filming, public fireworks displays, or for bonfires at ceremonial events are allowed with a proper permit. Please contact Office of the Fire Marshal or visit [www.sbcfire.org](http://www.sbcfire.org) for information on how to obtain a Special Event permit. Such open fires shall be conducted by a licensed professional or other responsible person, and inspected by fire department personnel, who shall determine that local climactic conditions are safe.
- Recreational fires within organized campgrounds or on private property are allowed when maintained in compliance with applicable regulations and restrictions of SBCFPD Ordinance. Please visit [www.sbcfire.org](http://www.sbcfire.org) for more information.
- Please check with CalFire within State Responsibility Areas, the United States Forest Service (USFS) within the Angeles and San Bernardino National Forests, or the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) within outlying desert regions for additional restrictions and permitting requirements.

**Unlawful fires may result in administrative or legal action against the person kindling the fire and/or the owner of the property on which the fire occurs.**
