#### **Section M - Waiver/Refund of Fees:**

- (1) This Section M is effective the date the Ordinance is effective. In the event of a disaster, or other good cause shown to serve a public purpose, the Fire Chief may defer payment of, waive, or refund any fee set forth in this Ordinance or any other fee levied by County Fire provided all of the following conditions are met:
  - a) Exigent conditions exist whereby obtaining Board of Directors approval of the fee waiver/refund/deferral would not be immediately feasible; and
  - b) County Fire receives concurrence from its Chief Executive Officer.
- (2) Except as otherwise provided by law, the Board of Directors, by Board action, can defer payment of, waive, or refund any fee set forth in this Ordinance or any other fee levied by County Fire provided one of the following conditions is met:
  - (A) The service for which the fee was levied has not and will not be performed, or
  - (B) The fee was collected in error, or
  - (C) For other good cause shown, provided such waiver/refund would serve a public purpose.
- (3) Notwithstanding (1) and (2) of this Section M, the Fire Chief may refund:
  - (A) Any fee collected in error or that results in an overpayment, and/or

(B) Unused deposit monies on actual cost projects when all charges for the project have been recorded.

Note: Pursuant to Government Code section 29375.1, the San Bernardino County Fire Protection District shall not be required to issue a refund of \$10.00 or less.
