Needles, California: **The San Bernardino County Fire District**, CalRecycle and City of Needles has announced a Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Event on Saturday, March 5th, 2022.

People can drop off household hazardous waste items from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. PT at the City of Needles Public Works Department Yard located at 112 Robuffa Street just south of East Broadway.

Household hazardous waste items include antifreeze, e-waste, batteries, electronics, oil, oil filters, and much more. Transport no more than 15 gallons or 125lbs in containers larger than 5 gallons. Containers must be sound and not leaking.

Only for residents of San Bernardino County, California, no business waste will be accepted. Please have all waste in the back of the vehicle. This is funded by CalRecycle.

Semi Truck Fire Closes Down Two Lanes Of Northbound I-15 Tuesday Afternoon

CAJON PASS, CA. (Pain In The Pass) >> Two lanes of northbound Interstate 15 were closed for two hours after a semi truck caught fire in the Cajon Pass Thursday afternoon.

California Highway Patrol, **San Bernardino County Fire** Department, and San Bernardino National Forest firefighters were getting calls of a white semi tractor on fire. The vehicle was located about two miles before the Oak Hill Road off ramp in the right shoulder. The semi fire happened on Thursday about 2:21pm February 10, 2022. California Highway Patrol and firefighters were on the scene and had to temporarily shut down the #4 lane and the slow lane while they worked on getting the semi fire put out.

Traffic backup quickly and firefighters had the fire out in about a half of a hour. Everybody did escape the semi before it became fully engulfed. No injuries were reported at the scene. It's was reported the semi brakes were on fire. The official cause of the vehicle fire is unknown at this time. The semi was hauling a full load of food in the trailer and was intact with no fire damage.

44-Year-Old Pomona Man ID'd In Fatal Rollover Crash On The 210 Freeway

UPLAND, CA. (Pain In The Pass) >> A 44-year-old Pomona man killed in a rollover crash Tuesday morning on the 210 freeway.

California Highway Patrol and **San Bernardino County Fire** Department were called to the scene at about 1:08am Tuesday, February 8, 2022. The crash was located on the eastbound side of the 210 freeway near the Mountain Avenue onramp. From reports Anthony Drapeau, age 44, a resident of Pomona driving a silver Mazda 3 sedan was reported to be in the carpool lane when the vehicle veered to the right. Drapeau hit the dirt embankment and the vehicle rolled-over multiple times landing in the slow lane. Drapeau was ejected from the vehicle.

CHP and firefighters rendered aid to Drapeau. With life saving measure he was deceased at the scene. No further details have been provided at this time. This incident will be under investigation by the California Highway Patrol Rancho Cucamonga Office.
