CAJON PASS, CA. (Pain In The Pass) >> Southbound 15 about 2 Miles after Oak Hill Rd an accident with four vehicles blocking all lanes.

California Highway Patrol and firefighters from **San Bernardino County Fire Department** responded to the traffic accident. The crash happened Thursday morning at about 4:40am looks to be caused by the dense fog in the area and speed. There was one person injured and was transported by ambulance to a nearby hospital.

CHP traffic log stated a total of four vehicles involved: a tan Toyota Corolla with heavy front end damage, a white Mitsubishi Outlander, a gray mini van, and an unknown vehicle blocking lanes.

CHP issues a SIG Alert at 5:13am for all Southbound lanes due to the cleanup and removal of the vehicles.
