## TWENTYNINE PALMS HOME DAMAGED IN STRUCTURE FIRE SATURDAY

Firefighters overcame abandoned vehicles, ditches, trees, and large piles of burning debris to save a Twentynine Palms home from fire late Saturday night (September 25). According to **San Bernardino County Fire Battalion Chief Scott Tuttle**, fire crews were called to the 71000 block of Indian Trail in Twentynine Palms just before 10 p.m. for a report of an unknown fire, which was identified as a structure fire soon after. Crews arrived on the large parcel of land; which was surrounded in ½ acre of rubbish, debris, and trees well involved in fire with a nearby structure in imminent danger. Crews had a very difficult time accessing the home, navigating abandoned vehicles and large ditches on the property. A County Fire excavator had to be called to the scene to move heavy debris for engine crews to approach the fire. Crews laid out significant lengths of hose to reach the blaze, extinguishing the fire in about one hour and saving the structure with minimal damage. There were no reported injuries and the cause of the fire is under investigation.

## Multiple-Vehicle Crash On NB I-15 Bear Valley Rd Exit Monday Evening

HESPERIA, CA. (Pain In The Pass) >> Several vehicles were involved in the crash on northbound Interstate 15, Monday evening and one person was taken to a hospital.

California Highway Patrol and firefighters from **San Bernardino County Fire Department** responded to the traffic accident. The accident was reported at about 5:51pm, Monday September 27, 2021, northbound Interstate at the 15 Bear Valley Road exit. It was reported to be a four vehicle crash. One of the cars in the center divider was a blue Honda Civic. The other three cars were in the right shoulder, a black Volkswagen Beetle with heavy driver side damage, a black BMW 3 Series sedan with heavy rear-end damage and a silver Ford F-250 that rolled over several times and landed in the ditch.

At least one person was taken to a local hospital with unknown injuries. There was no immediate information about the circumstances surrounding the crash. Traffic was backed up for about four miles before the traffic lanes were reopened. This incident will be under investigation by the California Highway Patrol Victorville Office.
