Two-Alarm Fire Damages San Bernardino Building

Date/Time: 11/10/21, 4:01PM

Location: 500 block West Baseline, San Bernardino.

Incident: Commercial Structure Fire

Summary:

This afternoon San Bernardino County Firefighters were dispatched to a reported commercial structure fire in the area of W. Baseline & N. Acacia, San Bernardino. Multiple 911 callers reported smoke and fire from a commercial building with four people potentially trapped.

Crews arrived within four minutes to find heavy smoke and fire from a 20,000 square foot commercial occupancy. Due to the fire involvement & potential trapped victims, a second alarm was quickly requested. Arriving firefighters initiated an aggressive interior fire attack, making a search for potential victims a priority. Firefighters on the roof and interior work to keep the fire from spreading throughout the large building. Despite a well involved fire, firefighters successfully knocked the fire down in 35 minutes. No victims were found and all searches of the building were clear. #SBCoFD Fire Investigators were requested to complete a cause and origin investigation.

San Bernardino County Fire responded with Nine Engines, Three Trucks, Two Battalion Chiefs, an Air/Light unit and three fire investigators.
