

Late-night fire displaces eight

TWENTYNINE PALMS — A mobile home was destroyed and a trailer was damaged in a fire that struck late Sunday night, Jan. 9, at the Bella Vista Mobile Home Park in the 70000 block of Twentynine Palms Highway. Eight people were displaced by the fire, four from the original mobile home and four from an adjacent mobile home.

One minor injury was reported and one person was transported by Morongo Basin Ambulance to a local hospital. Firefighters were dispatched to the blaze at 12:54 a.m. Monday, Jan. 10. Firefighters from the downtown Twentynine Palms fire station arrived to find a mobile home well-involved with multiple immediate exposures.

"Firefighters attacked the fire, working to keeping the fire from spreading to the adjacent mobile homes," Battalion Chief Mike McClintock reported.

The fire quickly spread to a nearby trailer but firefighters limited the fire to the wall and saved the remainder of the next door house. The fire was knocked down within 15 minutes of arrival. **San Bernardino County Fire** responded with three engines, a battalion chief and a fire investigator. Combat Center fire assisted.
