Rollover Accident Causes Traffic Jam On Northbound I-15 In Hesperia

HESPERIA, CA. (Pain In The Pass) >> A rollover crash Friday morning caused a big traffic jam on northbound Interstate 15 in the Hesperia area.

California Highway Patrol and firefighters from **San Bernardino County Fire** Department responded to the traffic crash. The rollover crash was reported on northbound Interstate 15 about a mile before the Bear Valley Road exit. This incident happened around 10:11am Friday morning on March 4, 2022. The California Highway Patrol traffic log reported that a black Chevrolet Tahoe lost control spun out and went off the right side of the roadway. Then collided with the ditch, rolled over and landed on it's wheels in the slow lane.

Emergency crews said at least one person with unknown injuries was transported by ambulance to a local hospital. Traffic was backed up all the way to Oak Hill Road exit that's over a 5 mile backup. This incident will be under investigation by the California Highway Patrol Victorville Office. Additional details were limited at this time.

CAJON PASS, Calif. (VVNG.com) — A multi-vehicle traffic collision on the southbound I -15 freeway in the Cajon Pass is blocking lanes and causing additional traffic Friday morning.

It happened at about 5:57 am, on March 4, 2022, just north of the escape ramp in the no. 1 lane. **San Bernardino County Fire** responded to the incident and confirmed four vehicles were involved and no injuries were reported.

The rain and fog produced for most of the very early commute have cleared out for now. More rain is expected to begin later this evening and will continue into Saturday morning. The San Bernardino County Mountains are forecasted to receive snowfall.

A Wind Advisory issued by the US National Weather Service for the Apple Valley and Lucerne Valleys goes into effect from 4:00 pm this afternoon until Saturday at 4:00 am.

Motorcyclist Killed Has Been ID After A Head-On Crash Into Pickup Truck On Hwy 18

LLANO, CA. (Pain In The Pass) >> A 48-year-old Palmdale woman died Sunday afternoon when her motorcycle crashed head-on into a pickup truck on Highway 18, authorities said.

California Highway Patrol and firefighters from **San Bernardino County Fire** Department responded to the fatal traffic collision. The crash was reported at about 1:16pm, Sunday February 27, 2022. The traffic collision location was on eastbound Pearblossom Highway (Hwy 18) by the bridge over the train track, near 263rd Street in the town of Liano.

The woman was driving a 2020 black Harley-Davidson motorcycle, with a male passenger, eastbound on Hwy 18, when "for an unknown reason the riders traveled over the double yellow lines into the westbound lane," the CHP report states. The motorcyclists crashed head-on into a 2021 silver Toyota Tundra that was traveling westbound on Hwy 18, according to the CHP report.

CHP officials said driver of the motorcyclist was pronounced dead at the scene and the male rider a passenger was in critical condition. Firefighters requested a medical helicopter to transport the rider to a local trauma center. Los Angeles Sheriff Air Rescue Helicopter #5 landed on the highway to transport the rider to Antelope Valley Hospital in critical condition. No update on the male condition. The pickup truck's driver and passenger only had minor injuries in the collision.

The deceased motorcyclist has been identified as 48-year-old Gina Jones of Palmdale, according to the Los Angeles County Coroner's Office.
