Firefighters Respond to Garage Fire in Hesperia

Date/Time: 7/28/2021, 4:10pm
Location: 13K block Sultana Street, Hesperia
Incident: 21-177896 / Structure Fire

Summary: This afternoon San Bernardino County Fire received multiple reports of a structure fire on Sultana Street in the City of Hesperia. Callers stated multiple explosions could be heard from the garage. A first alarm response was dispatched with the first unit arriving shortly after dispatch. Medic Engine 305 arrived to find a two story single family home with moderate smoke conditions from the attached garage. Upon contact with homeowners it was found all occupants had exited prior to arrival.

Firefighters deployed hose lines to the garage as they made entry. The home was confirmed to be empty as crews moved in to check if the fire had extended into the attic or living space of the home. Only light smoke was found inside the house with no extension of fire into that area. A quick knockdown was achieved with the main damage isolated to contents in the garage. Fire crews were committed approximately 30 minutes for overhaul operations.

San Bernardino County Fire responded with three medic engines, one medic squad, one medic ambulance, one truck, and one chief officer for a total of 17 personnel. Victorville City assisted with two engines. No injuries were reported to firefighters or civilians.
