## **County Firefighters Respond to Early Morning Structure Fire in the City of Hesperia**

**Date/Time:** December 30, 2021 2:07AM  
**Location:** 15K block Mesquite Ave, Hesperia CA.  
**Incident:** Residential Structure Fire 21-315049

### **Summary:**

Just before 2 am this morning, San Bernardino County Fire responded to multiple reports of a structure fire in the City of Hesperia. ME302 arrived to find a single story home with fire showing from one side, as well as smoke from all attic vents. Both occupants were found outside of the home upon arrival. Crews initial actions were to deploy lines and initiate an exterior attack. This knocked down the bulk of the fire. As additional resources arrived firefighters made entry to confirm the home was clear for any occupants and continue fire suppression. Moderate smoke conditions were encountered until truck crews ventilated from the roof above.

Minor extension was found in the attic with the main portion of fire contained to the fireplace / living room of the home. Knockdown of the fire was achieved in approximately 15 minutes.

No injuries to firefighters were reported. Three engines, one truck company, one chief officer, one medic ambulance, and one investigator, totaling 16 personnel from County Fire were assigned to the incident. Victorville City assisted with one engine. The cause remains under investigation by the office of the Fire Marshal.
